LAKE PLANNING GRANT APPLICATION**

**WHEREAS**, a water quality assessment need has been determined for Little Sturgeon Bay and the associated sub watershed to address nuisance aquatic vegetation and overall health of the bay.

**AND WHEREAS**, Little Sturgeon Bay has met the criteria to be classified as a “lake” based on the basin morphology, recreational use factors and other various parameters that are similar to inland lakes;

**AND WHEREAS**, the local community is interested in and supports a project that will produce a final report that contains information on water chemistry, specific watershed land use, aquatic vegetation control recommendations and nutrient/sediment inputs into Little Sturgeon Bay;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has promulgated Chapter 119 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code to provide a cost-share grant program for Comprehensive Lake Management Planning;

**AND WHEREAS**, the Door County Soil and Water Conservation Department is concerned with the planning, management and protection of Little Sturgeon Bay;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Town Board of the Town of Gardner does resolve to support and recommend acceptance of the application by the Door County Soil and Water Conservation Department for a Lake Management Planning Grant.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the Door County Soil and Water Conservation Department and the Lake Management Coordinator of the DNR-Lake Michigan District Office in Green Bay Wisconsin.
