**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN ADVISORY REFERENDUM
FOR THE TOWN OF GARDNER REGARDING
ESTABLISHING ZONING WITHIN THE TOWN**

WHEREAS, the Town of Gardner has been given village powers pursuant to Wis. Stat. 60.62(1); and

WHEREAS, the Town of Gardner has opted out of Door County Comprehensive Zoning and therefore all property within the Town is not currently subject to zoning regulation; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of zoning within the Town will require elector approval; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors for the Town of Gardner, Door County, believe it is in the best interest for the Town of Gardner to hold an advisory referendum regarding the establishment of zoning within the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Gardner does hereby order that the question regarding establishing zoning within the town shall be submitted to the electors of the town in an advisory referendum question at the spring election to be held on April 6, 2021.

The question to be placed on said ballot shall read as follows:

Shall the Town of Gardner pursue establishing zoning regulations within the Town? ___ Yes ___ No


NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the Town Board of the Town of Gardner does hereby adopt the foregoing resolution.
